Tower 42, previously known as the NatWest Tower, is one of London's most iconic buildings and is currently the eighth tallest tower in Greater London. It was built between 1971 and 1980 but continues to look modern and offer excellent facilities to the people and businesses located there. The wide range of functions the building fulfils means it can be a challenge to manage and since March 2017 Ecotile interlocking floor tiles have been used to solve some of the flooring problems in this unique environment.

In the public areas of the building attractive carpet, marble or tiles reinforce the impression of stylish luxury you would expect from one of London's most prestigious buildings. However, behind the scenes a more robust floor covering is required to cope with heavy loads of supplies for the restaurants and shops etc. Many of these have to be transported on pallet trucks so the point loading is quite high and was breaking down the screed in the service corridors. The volume of traffic is high so finding time to repair the problems areas was an issue and Chris Jackson, Operations Manager of Tower 42, realised a tough loose lay flooring such as interlocking floor tiles was the answer to his problem.
